1. Entry Eligibility:

- Granville Students or Residents: Any student attending school in Granville, or anyone residing within the Granville Exempted Village School district (GEVSD)*
- o Grade/Age: 4th Grade Adult
- 2. **Submission Dates**: Work will be accepted from April 1, 2025 to June 30, 2025.
- 3. **Submission Types**: We accept submissions in the following categories: fiction, non-fiction, and poetry.
- 4. **Formatting**: All written submissions should be double-spaced, in Times New Roman or Arial font, size 12.

5. Word Count:

- o **Fiction and Non-fiction**: No more than 2.000 words.
- Poetry: No more than 3 pages per poem, single-spaced.
- 6. **Submission Limits**: You may submit no more than 2 pieces of written work.
